Scam targeting senior citizens. A person claiming to be a Huntsville Utilities employee calls and states you are eligible for a senior citizen discount and then asks for financial information. We know of at least one instance where a customer provided the scammer with his credit card information. If you receive such a call, it is a scam! Just hang up! Please share this information with senior citizen friends and family members. If you think you have been the victim of a scam, contacting your financial institution and local law enforcement immediately.
